TRAINING SCHEDULE: October 1, 2022- March 31, 2023

Please let us know if you are planning to attend. It is imperative that your pre-register for all classes you want to attend. Failure to do so may result in the class being cancelled for low enrollment, failure of the instructor to bring enough materials for all students who arrive, or refusal to allow you to attend the class in situations where enrollment is limited. If you are signed up for a class, please notify the Academy within 24 hours before the class that you will not be unable to attend. This may give someone else an opportunity to take your place.

All training will be held at the LSO Training Academy at 801 Main Street at no charge, unless otherwise specified.

Training Mandates & Certificates

There are two 24-month periods in the current training cycle which ends on August 31, 2025. The first 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2021 and ends on 08/31/2023. The second 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2023 and ends on 08/31/2025, which is also the conclusion date of the 48-month training cycle.

- Those holding a BASIC PEACE OFFICER Certificate or no certificate will be required to have Cultural Diversity #3939, Special Investigative Topics #3232, Crisis Intervention Training #3843 and De-escalation #1849.
- Those holding an INTERMEDIATE or higher do not have specific courses (other than the State and Federal Law Update Course)

Student Prerequisites (TCOLE Rule §221.11):

(a) To qualify for a mental health officer proficiency certificate, an applicant must meet the following requirements:

(1) currently appointed as a peace officer, county jailer, or justice of the peace;

(2) at least two years' experience as a peace officer, county jailer, or justice of the peace;

(3) if not currently a commissioned peace officer or county jailer, an applicant must meet the current enrollment standards;

(4) if an applicant is a commissioned peace officer or county jailer, an applicant must not ever have had a license or certificate issued by the commission suspended or revoked;

(5) if an applicant is a commissioned peace officer or county jailer, an applicant must have met the continuing education requirements for the previous training cycle;

(6) successful completion of a training course in emergency first aid and lifesaving techniques (Red Cross or equivalent); and

(7) successful completion of the current mental health officer training course and pass the approved examination for mental health officer proficiency. (b) The effective date of this section is January 14, 2010.

Additionally, the student must have taken:

- De-escalation (TCOLE Course #1849) AND
- Crisis Intervention Training (TCOLE Course #1850) OR Mental Health for Jailers (TCOLE Course #4900)

Please note: Peace officers who completed the Basic Peace Officer Course after 2019 (BPOC 1000667, 1000696, 1000720), will have both 1849 and 1850 and meet the enrollment requirements.
