**Training Mandates & Certificates**

There are two 24-month periods in the current training cycle which ends on August 31, 2025. The first 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2021 and ends on 08/31/2023. The second 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2023 and ends on 08/31/2025, which is also the conclusion date of the 48-month training cycle.

Having an in-depth knowledge of case law will lay the foundation to empower all police officers to perform their jobs confidently and legally. Throughout this course intended for Texas police officers, Instructor Zach Miller will examine, review, and explain significant U.S. Supreme Court and Texas State Specific Case Law that is relevant to search and seizure. The goal of this course is to demonstrate how this case law can affect how police officers must perform their duties. Miller will teach students how to avoid evidence exclusion, increase convictions, and reduce civil liability, and he will share his own personal experiences of actively applying case law to his policing.
