TRAINING SCHEDULE: October 1, 2024-March 31, 2025

Please let us know if you are planning to attend. It is imperative that you pre-register for all classes you want to attend. Failure to do so may result in the class being cancelled for low enrollment, failure of the instructor to bring enough materials for all students who arrive, or refusal to allow you to attend the class in situations where enrollment is limited. **If you are signed up for a class, please notify the Academy within 24 hours before the class that you will not be unable to attend.** This may give someone else an opportunity to take your place. All training will be held at the LSO Training Academy at no charge, unless otherwise specified at: 801 Main Street Lubbock, Texas 79401.

Training Mandates & Certificates

There are two 24-month periods in the current training cycle which ends on August 31, 2027. The first 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2023 and ends on 08/31/2025. The second 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2025 and ends on 08/31/2027, which is also the conclusion date of the 48-month training cycle.

All Licensed Peace Officers with or <u>without</u> an Intermediate (or higher) Proficiency Certification (includes County Sheriffs and Deputy Constables):

<u>Current 2-year Training Unit</u>: (09/01/23 - 08/31/25): Minimum 40 hours of training to <u>include</u>:

- o Legislative Update course #3188 in-person or on MyTCOLE 3.0
- o 16 hours of ALERRT training*
- o Finding Wellness Building a Healthier Life #4202 in-person or on MyTCOLE 3.0.
- o Trauma-Informed Approach to Sexual Assault Investigations (MyTCOLE 3.0 online course #470 or in-person training course #4070), if not completed in the 9/1/21-

8/31/23 unit. An equivalent to this course will be #3264 – Special Investigator Certification.

*The passage of Senate Bill 1852 requires **all peace officers to attend ALERRT Level 1 training at least once** prior to 8/31/2027. Courses which will satisfy this requirement include #3311, #3313, and train-the-trainer #3315. This new law also requires that every peace officer complete 16 hours of ALERRT training every two-year unit going forward.

Peace officers who have previously completed course #3311, #3313, or #3315 and have at least one of these courses documented on their TCOLE training record do not need to repeat ALERRT Level 1 training; however, they must take at least 16 hours of ALERRT training during this 2-year training unit before 8/31/2025. Courses which will satisfy the 16-hour requirement are included in the approved list below.

Peace officers who do NOT have course #3311, #3313, or #3315 documented on their TCOLE training record are encouraged to complete course #3311 during this current training unit prior to 8/31/2025 as their 16-hour continuing education requirement if at all possible. If not completed during this training unit, they MUST have completed #3311 prior to 8/31/2027 in accordance with Senate Bill 1852.

The following course numbers count towards the ALERRT training mandate: #3381, #3380, #3376, #3377, #3394, #3393, #3317, #3318, #3311, #3382, #3392, #3312, #3315, #3357, #3607, #3606, #3355, #78052, #667371, #3356. **If not completed in the 09/01/2021-08/31/2023 unit.

<u>Current 4-year Training Cycle</u>: (09/01/21 - 08/31/25): All Licensed Peace Officers <u>without</u> an Intermediate (or higher) Proficiency Certification must complete:

- o Cultural Diversity #3939 or #394 (8 Hrs.)
- o Crisis Intervention Training #3843 or #1850 (8 Hrs.)
- o Special Investigative Topics #3232 (8 Hrs.)
- o De-escalation #1849 (8 Hrs.)

County Jailers:

• Cultural Diversity course (#3939 or #394) every 4-yr training cycle by 08/31/2025. If you have an active Peace Officer license <u>and</u> a Peace Officer Intermediate Proficiency Certificate or higher, you do not need to complete Cultural Diversity.

Telecommunicators: Current 2-year Training Unit: (09/01/23 - 08/31/25):

- A minimum of 20 hours of training to include Cardiac Emergency Communications (#786).
- A current, nationally recognized CPR certification is required in order to enroll.
