K9 Arlo Memorial Service Information

The Lubbock County Sheriff's Office will be holding a memorial service for K9 Arlo this afternoon. K9 Arlo passed away on 10/28/2025 during a training session. He was sent for a medical exam to determine his cause of death. The results from that exam concluded K9 Arlo suffered from cardiac arrest, most likely from a heart attack. He was the LSO's oldest working K9 and scheduled to retire in early 2026. K9 Arlo started with the agency in December 2021. During his career, he aided deputies in 125 arrests, seized over 22 kilos of narcotics, and over \$300,000 in illegal funds.

Due to limited space, this event is restricted to the surrounding agency K9 personnel, LSO employees, Texas Anti-Gang Center affiliates and local media stations. The service will start with an escort from the veterinary clinic at 1300. The procession will travel down Main Street and pass by the county courthouse between 1310-1320 before coming to a stop in front of the LSO Academy located at 801 Main Street. The LSO Honor Guard will be stationed in front of the Academy waiting for the escort's arrival. The service itself will be held in classrooms 1 and 2 of the LSO Academy. Speakers for the service include Judge Cutis Parrish, Lt. Chris Daniel, and Sheriff Kelly Rowe.

Once the service concludes, a memorial wreath will be placed in the public lobby of the Sheriff's Office at 712 Broadway until 12/8 for public viewing. The Sheriff's Office would like to thank Resthaven Funeral Home and Lone Star Decorating for helping us plan this event and transfer the classroom space for the service.
